—RACING—

The Leland Yacht Club is rich in the tradition of racing. There was a great resurgence of competitive racing after the end of World War II. Over the years, there have been strong fleets of Snipes, National One Designs, Lightnings, 470's, Butterflies, and Lasers.

Series Races occur Wednesdays and Saturdays, mid-June through early-August. The course will be set at 1:30 p.m. Please check in with the race committee at that time. Racing will start promptly at 2:00 p.m.

Member Sail: By appointment, please call or stop by to sign up.

EQUIPMENT: Leland's fleet consists of Flying Juniors and Butterflies.

SAFETY: A top priority at Leland Sailing School. A swim test is required. All students must wear a life jacket and shoes while on the docks and sailing.

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS: All students must be at least 8 years old, and demonstrate basic swimming skills. Daily needs include a towel, bathing suit, shoes, a Personal Flotation Device (PFD) and sunscreen.

CLINICS: Periodic clinics will be given by some of Leland Yacht Club's own accomplished sailors. Look for notices posted on our bulletin board throughout the season.

Level One: In Sailing School, the basic learn-to-sail course covers boat safety, boat care, general boat handling on all points of sail, nomenclature, weather, self-rescue techniques, and more.

Level Two Building on the skills from Level I, the Level II sailors will improve their skills in all aspects of sailing and be introduced to racing. The more advanced students will perfect their sailing skills and learn to race. They will also begin to learn racing rules and techniques.
